As we come to the close of this year, many people will make resolutions for the New Year. This is a great time to consider and make fresh commitments for the New Year. Generally, when people make resolutions or commitments, it concerns some area of change. They want to make some kind of change from the previous year.

I would ask you to consider making spiritual changes. We are always in need of spiritual change and growth. No one has reached the place in the Christian life that these things are not needed (**Philippians 3:13-14**). The foundation of this change is prayer. It is through prayer that we receive God's help and power to change.

Praying For Your Church's Spiritual Growth

Father, I plead that the believers of Church will desire You above all things on earth. Though our heart and flesh may fail, I ask that You will be the strength of our heart and our portion forever (Psalm 73:25-26). Father, I plead in the name of Jesus that the believers of will love Your Word. I ask that we will dig into the Word daily, reading, savoring, meditating on, memorizing, and putting its truth into practice (Psalm I 19:97).
I ask that the believers of Church would stand mature and complete in all of the will of God as revealed in His Word (Colossians 4:12).
I pray that the believers of Church will continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving. Release a spirit of prayer in this church; stir us and teach us to pray (Colossians 4:2).
Lord, I pray that the believers of Church would be filled with the Holy Spirit on a daily basis and that we would not quench or grieve the Holy Spirit who lives inside of us (Ephesians 5:18).
Create the mind of Christ in the believers of Church. Enable the

Praying For Personal Growth

The following are Scripture prayers that you can pray for personal growth and change. None of us have attained to perfection; we must keep striving to change and grow in our faith. The following prayers can aid you in seeking God for this change. Some may be more needful for you than others. You might consider praying them over time as a part of your regular prayer life.

Father, create within me a clean heart. O God of my salvation, renew a right spirit within me (**Psalm** 51:10).

Righteous Father, I confess my inability to change myself. I find myself doing the evil that I don't want to do while not doing the good that I want to practice. This crushes me and I plead for Your help, O God. Change me, O God. Transform me by Your power and grace (Romans 7:18-19).

O God, create within me a greater hunger for Your Word and for You. Father, I plead that my hunger for Your Word and You will root out and replace my lust for sin and the world (**Psalm 42:I-2**).

Father, teach me how to pray. Show me how to communicate with You. Fill me with the grace and discipline to spend time alone with You each day (Matthew 6:6; Luke II:I).

Father, teach me how to worship. Show me how to worship You in the way that will delight Your heart and

minister to You. I want my whole life to be a worship service to Your glory and honor (**Psalm 147:1**).

Father, grant me a deeper and greater spirit of repentance in my life. I pray that I will hate sin and will confront it in every area of my life (Acts 5:31).

O God, create a humble spirit in me; don't let my pride keep me from growing spiritually and experiencing Your transformation (James 4:6).

Father, search me and show me what changes I need to make in my life. Open my eyes to what You want to do in my life (**Psalm 139:23-24**).

Your Word says that I am dead to sin. Empower me to say "No!" to sin and "Yes" to what is right in Your sight (Romans 6:11).

Father, I'm forgetting the things that are behind me. I releasing all the guilt, the shame, and the brokenness that sin has caused in my life. Now I'm pressing on to genuine transformation. I'm pursuing the change that You want to unleash in my life. I want to be a trophy of Your grace and love. Provide me with the grace and power to seek You and experience this transformation (**Philippians 3:14-15**).

Father, help me to take up my cross, deny myself, and follow Your will each day (Mark 8:34).

Father, lessen my love for the world and all that it offers. Weaken and destroy its hold on my life. Increase my love for You. I want to love You first, best, and most of all (Matthew 22:36-38).

Father, deliver me from the snares and attacks of the enemy, Satan. He wants to lead me back to the old path of sin and rebellion. I ask You to guide me in the path of righteousness for Your great name's sake (2 Corinthians 2:11).

Father, I pray that I will have deep and genuine fellowship with other believers. Surround me with believers who will pray for me and encourage me in my walk with You and that I can do the same for them (**Hebrews I 0:25**).

Father, I ask that my love for You and for others will grow and abound more than ever in my walk before You (I Thessalonians 1:3).

The Church Of Jesus Christ Matthew 16:18

In **Matthew 16:18**, Jesus Christ says, "I will build my church." This text can help us to pray for our churches. I'd ask you to consider the following truths and how to use them for prayer.

The Invincibility Of The Church – "I will build" Jesus Christ asserts that He is the Builder of the church. It is through the power and grace of Jesus Christ that people are added to the church (Acts 2:39, 2:47, 5:14). Christ does use His people – their witness, their ministry, and their lifestyle – to draw people to Himself/. However, He is clear – He will build the church. He has and He will build it

Lord Jesus, I praise You that You are the Builder of the church. Your power and grace builds and sustains Your church. By Your Word and Spirit, add people to this church. Draw them to Yourself and to Your church.

The Intimacy With The Church - "my"

When He refers to the church, Jesus says "my" church. This refers to intimacy and involvement. Jesus Christ loves and is personally involved in His church. How is He intimately involved with His church?

- He purchased the church (Acts 20:28)
 Lord Jesus, You purchased this church with Your own blood. Continue to have mercy on us and to grant us favor and power.
- He provides for the church (Ephesians 5:29)
 Lord Jesus, Your Word says that You nourish and cherish the church. I plead with You to sustain and meet every need this church has.

 Feed us with Your Word through our pastor and teachers. Grant us the fresh assurance of Your cherishing love.
- He protects the church (Ephesians 1:22).
 Lord Jesus, the Word of God says that all things have been put under Your feet. You
