PRAYING FOR THE HURTING

You live in a fallen world. It's inevitable that you're going to be hurt. Your heart is going to be wounded; it's going to be broken. It's not a matter of if; it's a matter of when and how much. You're going to sin. Others are going to sin against you. All this wreaks havoc with your emotional life.

At the same time, this is true of your church. Your church is full of broken people. In spite of outward appearances, the pews are filled with people whose emotions have been infected and affected by sin. Every pew has people who have a broken hearts, emotions wrecked by sin.

However, the good news is that God is the Healer. God does heal our broken bodies (**Exodus 15:26**). Yet, He is also the healer of the brokenhearted (**Psalm 147:3**). He is close to the brokenhearted and saves those crushed in spirit (**Psalm 34:18**). We can seek Him and receive His healing power.

This issue of *The Prayer Closet* will focus on praying for the hurting. This issue will provide you with a variety of Scripture prayers and models on how to pray about this issue. Part of discipleship is conforming our emotions to God's standard revealed in His Word. These prayer aids are offered to help you pray for yourself and others.

Scripture Prayers For Emotional Healing

Father, You are the Healer of the brokenhearted. You declare that You bind up their wounds. Because it is Your nature to heal, I ask You to heal ______ of all his/her emotional wounds. By Your love and power, remove the hurt and anger that ______ is experiencing. Help him/her move on to emotional wholeness (**Psalm 147:3**).

Father, I ask that ______ would trust in You as his/her Healer. Build his/her faith to depend on You as his/her Healer. Reveal to ______ that You are filled with mercy and grace. Convict him/her of Your willingness and ability to heal him/her (**Psalm** 103:8, 11).

Father, You are _____'s Creator. You have made his/her emotions. These emotions have been wounded; they have been torn apart. Sinful, negative emotions have been cultivated into his/her life. I plead for You to release Your power into his/her life. Remove the sinful, negative emotions that resulted from his/her emotional wounds. Heal ______ so that he/she can experience emotional health and wholeness (Genesis 1:27).

Father, _____ has experienced deep emotional wounds. However, I ask You to deliver him/her out of all of these. Heal _____ and cause him/her to grow from these wounds (**Psalm 34:19**).

Father, You promise to be near those who are brokenhearted. I pray that You would grant ______ a deeper experience of Your presence. Surround him/her with Your love. Cause him/her to know that You love him/her without reservation (**PsaIm 34:18**).

Father, You sent Jesus to heal the brokenhearted. You sent Him to set the captives free. I plead in the name of Jesus that ______ would experience complete emotional healing. In the name of Jesus, I pray that ______ would be set free from every past hurt that binds him/her. Through Your Son Jesus, heal ______ and grant him/her freedom from the consequences of his/her past hurts (Luke 4:18-19).

Father, I ask in the name of Jesus that You would bind Satan and his demons from ______. In the name of Jesus, I plead that they would no longer harass or oppress ______ through his/her emotional wounds. Deliver him/her from the attacks of the enemy through past emotional wounds. Heal

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him/her and cut off every avenue of the enemy in 's life (**I Peter 5:8**).

Father, I plead that _____ would seek You with all his/her heart. I ask that _____ would cry out to You for emotional healing. I plead that _____ would seek You with all his/her being and that You would release Your healing into his/her life (Jeremiah 29:13). Father, I ask You to set free from any unforgiveness in his/her life. Deeply convict him/her of any unforgiveness that he/she is harboring. Through Your grace and power, enable him/her to release the debt, the anger, and the damage into Your hands. I plead that he/she would forgive as You do for the sake of Christ (Matthew 6:14-15; Ephesians 4:32).

Father, grant _____ the strength and help to face the wounds of the past. I plead that _____ will not neglect or suppress the hurt or the pain. Empower him/her to face these things, to seek You for healing, and move on by Your grace and power. I pray that _____'s past would no longer hurt, hinder, or destroy _____'s present and future (Hebrews 13:5-6, 8).

Father, I pray that You would cultivate the fruit of Spirit in _____'s life. I plead with You to transform . Root out the sinful, negative emotions that have been cultivated in his/her life. Replace these things with Your fruit (Galatians **5:22-23**).

Father, _____ has been wounded. Yet, I plead for Your healing in his/her life. I ask that would forget those things that happened in the past and would press on to Your purpose and Your blessings for his/her future. I plead that _____ would keep his/her eyes focused on You. I ask that _____ would continue to seek You and experience to the fullest what You have purposed for him/her (Philippians 3:13).

Father, emotional hurts can produce sinful, negative attitudes and behaviors that can hinder and destroy relationships. I ask You to grant emotional healing to . I pray that You would deal with any sinful attitudes or behaviors in _____''s life that would hinder his/her relationships. I plead that You _ healthy, godly would grant relationships (Matthew 22:39).

Father, I plead that You would enable

confess and repent of any sinful responses to his/her emotional wounds. I pray that _____ would not see himself/herself as a victim, but would take responsibility for his/her responses (I John I:9; Proverbs 28:13).

Father, I pray that You would deliver _____

from harsh, negative attitudes about himself/herself. Cause him/her to know that there is hope, peace, and healing with You. Show him/her that You can transform his/her broken heart (Exodus 15:26).

Soaking Prayer

Soaking prayer is saturating a person with prayer. It is pleading for the release of God's healing power through numerous short prayers. You can do this as an individual. Yet, it is usually most effective as two or more believers pray in agreement, continually covering the person in prayer.

The following are short requests that you can use to soak a person in God's power and love so that they can experience emotional healing.

- Release Your healing power into _____'s life; be gracious to him/her.
- Cause to sense and know Your love as never before his/her life.
- Open his/her eyes to those wounds that have _____ bound and hurting.
- Remove the pain from _____'s life; fill his/her wounds with Your mercy.

- Remove anger and hatred from _____'s life; replace it with love.

The Word of God reveals that God is the Healer of the brokenhearted. He desires to deal with the hurt and the pain that you have experienced. He wills that you experience emotional wholeness – walking in the fruit of the Holy Spirit. He can and will do this.

Yet, you must understand that there are certain hindrances to emotional healing; there are some factors that can keep you from experiencing God's healing in your life. We need to examine these hindrances to receiving the healing that we are in desperate need of. We also need to pray for their removal.

Unbelief

Father, I plead in Jesus' name that ______ will trust You for genuine change in his/her life. Your Word says that we are to ask in faith without doubting. I ask that ______ will not doubt but seek You for the healing of the pain and bringing real change in his/her life (James 1:6-7).

Lack Of Forgiveness

Father, I ask that ______ would freely forgive others. I plead that ______ would not grieve the Spirit but that he/she will put away all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking along with all malice. I ask in Jesus' name that ______ will be kind to one others, tenderhearted, forgiving others, just as God in Christ forgave him/her (**Ephesians 4:30-32**).

Unconfessed Sin

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our lives. I ask in Jesus' name that ______ would confess and repent of sin in his/her life that he/she might experience Your healing work (**Psalm 66:18**).

Spiritual Warfare

A Victim Mentality
